**Meeting Date: April 3, 2017**

Arlington Village Council met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. Council Members Bell, Smith, Essinger, Blunk, Huffman and Dempster were present. Also present were Dean Glick, Beidelschies, Rasmussen, Fahy and Greg Glick.

Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Huffman seconded by Bell to approve the minutes from the March 20, 2017 meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

**Visitors:**

Dan and Stephanie Rader were present to discuss parking near their winery.

**Personnel Reports:**

Latta (Fire) – Not Present. Copies of the Department’s long range apparatus plan were distributed to Council.

Monday (Water & Sewer) – Not present, provided a written report on water/sewer operations. Will be on vacation April 10, 14 and 21.

Dean Glick (Streets & Parks) – Asked if language could be added to quotes accepted by the Village for setting start and completion dates for projects, provided a second street repair estimate for the 2017 paving program, reported Dura Edge has completed price field and will complete the other 3 fields as soon as weather permits.

Beidelschies (Board of Public Affairs) – Not Present.

Greg Glick (Fiscal Officer) – Highlighted the Cash Summary by Fund through March 31, 2017.

Rasmussen (Solicitor) – No Report.

Fahy (Blanchard Design Associates) – Has received the manhole inspection report. Gave a letter to Council not recommending angled parking on East Liberty Street.

**Committee Reports:**

Huffman (Finance, Fire & Capital Projects) – Reported the Village was not approved for a weather siren grant, has a pledge for \$1000 for the Park scoreboard and Huntington Bank has indicated they will donate to the project. Pledged \$30 to the Boot Campaign and encouraged other Village Officials to do the same.

Dempster (Maintenance, Safety & Street Lights) – A quote has been received from Land Tech to spray for mosquitos at a cost of \$4,680 for twelve applications.

Bell (Community Development & Business Relations,/EMS/Zoning/Trees) – Working with Jamie Insley on zoning issues.

Essinger (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – Presented a quote for Industrial Fluid Management to treat the lagoons at the sewage treatment plant for a cost of \$8,480.

Blunk (Parks & Recreation) – Presented a quote from USA Lawns to treat grass in the park for weeds with 2 applications at a cost of \$2,960. Recommended pool admission and season pass rates for 2017 remain the same as 2016.

Smith (Streets & Sidewalks) – Reported the Fire Department is purchasing new Christmas Decorations for the Village square.

Palmer (Mayor) – Commended the Fire Department for all the work they do for the Village.

**Old Business:**

**New Business:**

Motion by Blunk seconded by Bell for the 2017 pool admission and season pass rates to remain the same as 2016. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Blunk seconded by Dempster to approve Industrial Fluid Managements quote of \$8,480 to treat the lagoons at the Sewage Treatment Plant. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster seconded by Essinger to approve 12 applications for mosquito control by Land Tech at a cost of \$4,680. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Blunk seconded by Dempster to approve 2 applications of weed control in the Park by USA Lawn at a cost \$2,960 to treat the lagoons at the Sewage Treatment Plant. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Smith seconded by Essinger to not permit angle parking on East Liberty Street. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Huffman seconded by Bell to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Essinger seconded by Huffman to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of March 31, 2017. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Essinger and second by Bell for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
