Motion by Blunk seconded by Huffman to approve a \$3,209 change order to the new fire truck for safer steps. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Essinger seconded by Dempster to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Blunk and second by Essinger for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
