Motion by Essinger seconded by Clevidence to install speed bumps at various locations on Park and Mill Streets. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Smith seconded by Huffman to attach signage to the dug outs on Price Field indicating they were paid for by the VFW. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Huffman seconded by Dempster to excuse Waltermire from the meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Huffman seconded by Essinger to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Clevidence seconded by Dempster to enter executive session for the sole purpose of discussing personnel. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Essinger seconded by Dempster to leave executive session. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Essinger and second by Dempster for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
