Motion by Essinger and seconded by Dempster to approve the parade route for the parade honoring graduating Seniors. To be held on Sunday May 24 at 3:00 pm. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2020-10 increasing water rates by ten percent effective with the bills due July 15, 2020.

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2020-11 transferring \$20,000 from the General Fund to the Pool Fund. Motion by Essinger and second by Dempster to suspend the rules and give Ordinance 2020-11 its second and third readings. Roll call vote, all yes. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer gave second and third readings of Ordinance No 2020-11. Motion by Dempster and second by Clevidence to adopt Ordinance 2020-11. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Essinger to allow Good Hope Lutheran Church to angle park on the portion of Sumner Street next to the Church, on Sundays during the Route 68 construction. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Waltermire and seconded by Dempster to approve the opening of the pool following COVID-19 guidance at a date to be determined. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Waltermire and seconded by Dempster to approve the lifeguards and their rates of pay for the Summer. (Listing Attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Essinger seconded by Huffman to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Essinger and seconded by Dempster to go into executive session for the stated purpose of discussing personnel. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Huffman and seconded by Dempster to leave executive session. Voice vote, all yes.
