Arlington Village Council met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. Council Members Dempster, Barker, Bell, Huffman, Latta and Sparks present. Also present were Frater, Rasmussen, Glick and Beidelschies.

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Huffman seconded by Barker to approve the minutes from the May 2, 2022 regular meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker seconded by Huffman to approve the minutes from the May 12, 2022 special meeting meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

**Visitors:**

Barb Robinson and Thomas Barnett were present to discuss renting of the Mobile Home on Mill Street.

**Personnel Reports:**

TJ Huffman (Fire) – Not Present.

Frater (Water & Sewer) – Provided an update on Water and Sewer operations.

Price (Streets & Parks) – Not present.

Beidelschies (Board of Public Affairs) – Provided an update from BPA. BPA would like to ask for an advance of funds to pay semi-annual debt if necessary.

Greg Glick (Fiscal Officer) – Provided an update on Finances.

Rasmussen (Solicitor) – Provided an update on the dog situation on North Main St.

Fahy (Blanchard Design Associates) – Not present.

**Committee Reports:**

Huffman (Finance, Fire & Capital Projects) – Discussion was held placing a 2.5 mill levy on the fall ballot for the new fire truck.

Bell (Community Development & Business Relations, & Zoning) – Will ask for a revote on the Mobile Home rental status.

Sparks (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – No report.

Latta (Maintenance, Safety, Trees & Street Lights) – Ask Council to consider providing upto \$1500 for freight for the 2022 Fireworks and will ask for approval to have Scott Feller take care of 2 trees at 218 W. Liberty St. at a cost of \$1200.

Barker (Parks & Recreation) – Hopeful pool pump will be repaired and working next week.

Dempster (Streets, Sidewalks & EMS) – No report.

Smith (Mayor) – Discussion was held concerning having a fence along the railroad in the Park.

**Old Business:**

Motion by Bell and seconded by Sparks to rescind the motion requiring tenants to vacate the mobile home in 90 days and direct Rasmussen to put together a lease agreement for Council to consider. Roll Call vote, Barker, Sparks, Bell yes; Dempster, Huffman, Latta no; Smith broke the tie with a yes vote. Motion carried.

**New Business:**

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Resolution 1-2022 requesting the County Auditor to certify the amount to be collected from a 2.5 mill levy to finance purchase of a fire truck.

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Resolution 2-2022 requesting the Board of Elections place a 2.5 mill levy to finance purchase of a fire truck on the Fall ballot.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Barker to pay up to \$1500 for freight for the 2022 fireworks. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Dempster to authorize Scott Feller to take care of 2 trees at 218 W. Liberty St. at a cost of \$1200. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Bell to set the fee for swimming lessons at \$35 per session. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks and seconded by Bell to approve sealing and striping the parking lot at the Pool by Clean Line at a cost of \$6195, to be paid from the General Fund. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks and seconded by Bell to change the Zoning Board of Appeals from a Council of the whole Committee to a separate 5 member Board appointed by the Mayor and approved by

Council, with Members serving 5 year staggered terms. The original appointments to be one member for 1 year, one for 2 years, one for 3 years, one for 4 years and one for 5 years. Members will be compensated \$50 per meeting to be paid from the General Fund. Applications for zoning appeals before the Board will require a \$250 fee. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Huffman and seconded by Dempster to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker seconded by Dempster for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
