**Personnel Reports:**

TJ Huffman (Fire) – Provided an update on Fire Department operations.

Frater (Water & Sewer) – Not present.

Price (Streets & Parks) – Provided an update on Street and Park operations.

Beidelschies (Board of Public Affairs) – Provided an update from BPA.

Greg Glick (Fiscal Officer) – Provided an update on Finances. Discussion was held concerning a bill received for a dumpster that was provided to a private citizen to clean up an old house trailer.

Rasmussen (Solicitor) – Not present.

Fahy (Blanchard Design Associates) – Discussed various projects/issues with the water system.

**Committee Reports:**

Huffman (Finance, Fire & Capital Projects) – Discussion was held concerning a rental agreement for the mobile home on Mill St.

Bell (Community Development & Business Relations, & Zoning) – No report.

Sparks (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – No report.

Latta (Maintenance, Safety, Trees & Street Lights) – Commented on the new lights in front of the Municipal Building.

Barker (Parks & Recreation) – Heart and Soul for the Village will begin this Summer. 12 lounge chairs were purchased for the Pool.

Dempster (Streets, Sidewalks & EMS) – EMS Board still considering paying employees.

**Old Business:**

Fiscal Officer gave second reading of Resolution 1-2022 requesting the County Auditor to certify the amount to be collected from a 2.5 mill levy to finance purchase of a fire truck.

Fiscal Officer gave second reading of Resolution 2-2022 requesting the Board of Elections place a 2.5 mill levy to finance purchase of a fire truck on the Fall ballot.

**New Business:**

Motion by Barker and seconded by Bell to reimburse Denver Weihrauch \$165 for his family season pool pass, in appreciation of the work he did on the plumbing at the pool house. The work was provided at cost. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Bell to cancel the first meeting in July which falls on July 4. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Barker to have S&K Rolloff Service bill the previous property owners for the dumpster provided to clean up the old house trailer, since they are responsible for the clean-up. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Barker to require recognition plaques for trees in the Park to be no larger than 8 ½” x 11” and be flush mounted with all cost borne by the individual(s) requesting the plaque. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Latta and seconded by Huffman to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Bell seconded by Latta for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
