**Old Business:**

Motion by Latta and seconded by Dempster contract with The Bergren Associates to provide monitoring alarm system for the main lift station at a cost not to exceed \$7,240. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

**New Business:**

Motion by Barker and seconded by Bell to contract with USA Lawn for 2 applications of treatment for weeds on all sports fields and new areas purchased last year at a total cost of \$6,360 and up to 6 applications to treat all infields, all stone areas and fence rows throughout the growing season for vegetation control at a total cost of \$4,428. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to purchase 4 fire hydrant valves from Perrysburg Pipe at a total cost of \$4,260. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Huffman to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of February 28, 21023. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Huffman and seconded by Barker to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
