Motion by Latta and seconded by Sparks to approve a sewer billing credit of \$35.75 for Mark Newman at 201 N. Cumberland. Motion carried.

Motion by Huffman and seconded by Dempster to write off \$360.36 in old sewer utility accounts. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Dempster to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of August 31, 2023. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
