Motion by Dempster and seconded by Palmer to have Ohio CAT service a sewer system generator located at 526 N. Cumberland at a cost of \$1285.92. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to contract with Sydney Electric to replace 10 lights on the Council side of the Municipal Building at a cost of \$1937. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Directed Mayor to have the Zoning Inspector contact the Solicitor concerning a dog kennel that was constructed without a permit.

New Business:

Motion by Barker and seconded by Sparks to hold Spring cleanup day on May 25, 2024. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Latta to contract with Logan Electric for electric work in the park at a cost of \$2015.60. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Sparks to purchase a speed monitoring sign for West Main Cross Street from B. Traffic at a cost of \$4035.50. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks and seconded by Dempster to purchase a catch basin cover for a basin on Waterloo at a cost of \$606.18 from Perrysburg Pipe. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Latta to approve paying up-to \$1500 for the shipping of fireworks. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Barker to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of January 31, 2024. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Barker and seconded by Dempster to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
