Sparks (Community Development, Business Relations, & Zoning) – Board of Zoning Appeals denied request for a shed to remain in the incorrect spot. The Business Association is ready for Trick or Treat.

Barker (Parks & Recreation) – Discussion was held concerning a possible Memorial Bench in the Park in memory of Dean Glick.

Latta (Streets, Alleys, Sidewalks & Trees) – Discussion concerning sidewalks and street signs.

Tyzzzer (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – Todd Richard thanks the Village for allowing hunting geese on the sewer plant property.

Palmer (Mayor) – Paula Rossman would like to plant a permanent pine tree in the South lot for a Christmas Tree. Lions Club would like to place a sign with the other signs at the North entry to the Village of US 68.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Dempster to readvertise the 1996 Fire Truck on Gov Deals with no reserve. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Tyzzzer to cover the cost of placing a bench in the Park in Memory of Dean Glick. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Dempster to contract with the City of Findlay to install sign posts at a cost not to exceed \$2,500. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Tyzzzer and seconded by Latta to contract with Lima Armature for work on the Powell Drive lift station at a cost of \$4,432.50. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Lotz to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of September 30, 2025. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
