Dempster (Maintenance, Safety and Trees) – Discussion concerning the heater at the sewer plant, mailboxes damaged by snow plows and noted there is an opening on the EMS Board.

Old Business:

Fiscal Officer gave second reading of Ordinance 2025-13 for the proper care of animals or fowl and the enforcement of same. Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to approve Ordinance 2025-13. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to approve Resolution 01-2026 naming the main entry street to the new school “Red Devil Way” with the school address being “1 Red Devil Way”. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

New Business:

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to contract with Wyroc to install a new heating unit at the Sewer Plant at a cost not to exceed \$3000. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Sparks to join the Arlington Business and Professional Association. Annual cost \$50. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of January 31, 2026. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Dempster and seconded by Sparks to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
