Motion by Barker seconded by Latta to approve the minutes from the February 2, 2026 regular meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

TJ Huffman (Fire) – Provided an update on Fire Department operations.

Old Business:

Discussion was held concerning hiring an administrator. No action was taken.

New Business:

Motion by Lenhart and seconded by Sparks to adopt the Heart and Soul Statement. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to contract with Jolliff Cleaning to wax the Municipal Building floors at an estimated cost of \$1600-\$1700. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to change the Village's propane supplier to Cherry's Propane. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Sparks to contract with Critter Getter at a cost of \$705. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Tyzzzer and seconded by Dempster to contract with Logan Electric to replace a switch at the sewage lagoon at a cost of \$580. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Tyzzzer and seconded by Latta to contract with County electric to replace a switch at the sewage lift station at a cost of \$3800. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks seconded by Tyzzzer for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
