Jamie Insley (Zoning Inspector) – Not present.

Beidelschies (Board of Public Affairs) – Provided an update on BPA activities.

Rob Feighner (Solicitor) – Not present.

Greg Glick (Fiscal Officer) – Provided an update on finance issues.

Fahy (Village Engineer) – Provided an update on Village projects.

Committee Reports:

Lenhart (Finance, Fire & Capital Projects) – Gave an update on potential wage increases for employees.

Dempster (Maintenance, Safety and Trees) – EMS Board has appointed a new member. Working on estimates for repairs to the Scout building in the park.

Sparks (Community Development, Business Relations, & Zoning) – Discussed providing green

waste disposal in the Village and Regional Planning reinvestment areas.

Barker (Parks & Recreation) – Brought estimates for Park grass treatment. Received a request, from the School to use Park fields for practice.

Latta (Streets, Alleys, Sidewalks & Trees) – Discussed pot hole patching, installation of signs and start of the 2026 paving project.

Tyzzar (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – Smoke testing of sewer system has been delayed.

New Business:

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2026-04 amending pay ranges from Ordinance 2023-02. Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to suspend the rules and give Ordinance 2026-04 its second and third readings. Roll call vote, all yes. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer gave second and third readings of Ordinance 2026-04. Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to adopt Ordinance 2026-04. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Lenhart to support the Heart and Soul capital plan. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Lenhart and seconded by Barker to approve employee pay rate increases (See the attached listing), effective with the pay period that includes March 1, 2026. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Dempster to contract with Pleasant View Landscaping to fertilize (\$9,950) and treat weeds (\$750). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker, to allow the School to use fields for practice at a cost of \$200 per month. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Latta and seconded by Sparks to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of February 28, 2026. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Dempster and seconded by Latta to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
