**Old Business:**

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2026-05 appointing Derek Morrison as Village Administrator at a salary of \$70,000 with a \$450 monthly stipend in lieu of health insurance. Motion by Tyzzer and seconded by Sparks to suspend the rules and give Ordinance 2026-05 its second and third readings. Roll call vote, all yes. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer gave second and third readings of Ordinance 2026-05. Motion by Latta and seconded by Tyzzzer to adopt Ordinance 2026-05. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

**New Business:**

Motion by Tyzzzer and seconded by Barker to contract with Pine Ridge Pest and Litter Control for mosquito spraying at a cost of \$449 per application. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Latta to expend \$2000 to weather tight the Scout A-Frame building in the Park. Voice vote, 4 yes; Tyzzzer no. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Tyzzzer to approve the Cash Summary by Fund as of March 31, 2026. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Latta and seconded by Sparks to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Lenhart seconded by Barker for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
