Motion by Barker seconded by Dempster to approve the minutes from the April 6, 2026 regular meeting. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Derek Morrison (Administrator) – Provided a report on what Village employees had been doing.

Greg Glick (Fiscal Officer) – Provided an update on finance issues.

Dempster (Maintenance, Safety and Trees) – No report.

Sparks (Community Development, Business Relations, & Zoning) – No report.

Barker (Parks & Recreation) – Gave an update on the new playground and needed repairs to the pool fence.

Latta (Streets, Alleys, Sidewalks & Trees) – No report.

Tyzzzer (Water, Drainage & Sewer) – Discussed the need to increase sewer rates.

Palmer (Mayor) – Discussed potential location for shelter in case of inclement weather for those using the park

Old Business:

Motion by Latta and seconded by Sparks to amend Ordinance 2026-05 to include 2 weeks of vacation for Derek Morrison. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Tyzzzer to pay the Village Administrator’s salary 50% General Fund, 30% Water Fund and 20% Sewer Fund. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

New Business:

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2026-06 advancing \$10,000 from the General Fund to the Sewer Fund. Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to suspend the rules and give Ordinance 2026-06 its second and third readings. Roll call vote, all yes. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer gave second and third readings of Ordinance 2026-06. Motion by Dempster and seconded by Barker to adopt Ordinance 2026-06. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Fiscal Officer gave first reading of Ordinance 2026-07 increasing sewer rates by \$13 per month.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Tyzzzer to contract with Kramer Excavating to remove the old playground posts at a cost of \$1900. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Barker and seconded by Tyzzzer to contract with Town and Country Fence to complete work on the pool fence at a cost of \$975. Voice vote, All yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks and seconded by Tyzzzer to allow use of Field #2 at no charge for a softball tournament to benefit Jesse Coleman. The field will be lined once on Friday afternoon. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

With funds currently available to pay all obligations and funds available when the obligations were incurred, Motion by Latta and seconded by Barker to approve payment of the bills as presented (listing attached). Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sparks seconded by Tyzzzer for adjournment. Voice vote, all yes. Motion carried.
