

ORDINANCE 2008- 3

as amended

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SALARY FOR THE POSITION OF STREET COMMISSIONER, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: REPEAL. That all ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: STREET COMMISSIONER. That from and after January 1, 2008, the Street Commissioner shall be paid a salary as follows:

<u>Job Classification</u>	<u>Salary</u>
Street Commissioner	\$30,700.00/annually
Water License	\$ 1,000.00 add'l/annually
Sewer License	\$ 1,000.00 add'l/annually
Chemical Application License	\$ 1,000.00 add'l/annually <i>100.00</i>

In addition to the salary provided above, the Street Commissioner shall be entitled to overtime compensation for emergency water line replacement or repair and emergency snow plowing performed between the hours of 5:00 PM and 7:00 AM. Said overtime compensation shall be subject to approval by Council and shall be paid on an hourly basis at an hourly rate computed by dividing the annual salary by 2080 hours.

SECTION 3: In addition to the salary provisions set forth herein, the Street Commissioner shall be reimbursed for the cost of his health care in the amount of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,930.00) annually.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enact said salary schedule to provide for payment to said employee commencing January 1, 2008.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
