ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 57

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS, TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN APPROPRIATED FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, Two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the sum of Ten Thousand & 00/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the General Fund (#1000) for the purposes of paying current expenditures.

SECTION 2: That the sum of Ten Thousand & 00/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the Street Fund (# 3011) for the purposes of paying current expenditures.

SECTION 3: That the following sums be and the same are hereby transferred:

FROM:

General Fund (#1000)

\$ 10,000.00

TO:

Street Fund(# $\supseteq \in II$)

\$ 10,000.00

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to transfer said funds to meet current expenditures.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
