ORDINANCE NO. 2009- 27

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING RULES REGULATING ANIMALS IN THE PARK, ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF SAID RULES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, Two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the codified ordinances of the Village of Arlington be amended and the following section be enacted as follows:

§90.26 Rules regulating animals in the park

- (A) No person being the owner, harborer or person in control of any animal shall do any of the following:
- (1) Permit said animal to be in the park unless said animal is properly on a leash and under reasonable control of said owner, harborer or person in control of said animal. If said animal is of a type or breed of animal such that the State of Ohio has enacted specific rules regarding the proper leashing or control of said animal, then said animal is not permitted in the park unless said owner, harborer or person in control of said animal is in compliance with any more stringent or specific rules.
 - (2) Allow said animal to excrete waste in the park without taking any and all necessary steps to properly and completely remove said waste from the park or depositing same in a suitable waste receptacle.
- (B) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be subject to a fine of \$50.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
