ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 32

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto:


SECTION 1: That certain real property located in the 100 block of E. Liberty Street, Arlington, Ohio having Hancock County Auditor Parcel #31-0000071310 and belonging to the Village of Arlington, Ohio be and the same hereby is deemed no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer be and she hereby is authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of said real estate. Said advertisement shall appear once a week for five consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize said sale in order that the proper advertisement may occur prior to sale of the property.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
