

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-36

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS, TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN APPROPRIATED FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, Two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the sum of Thirty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighteen & 19/100 Dollars (\$39,818.19) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the Flood Disaster Relief Fund (# 205~~2~~) for the purpose of closing said fund and transferring the unexpended balance therein to the General Fund pursuant to RC §5705.14(D).

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby transferred pursuant to RC §5705.14(D):

FROM: Flood Disaster Relief Fund (# 205~~2~~) \$ 39,818.19


TO: General Fund (#1000) \$ 39,818.19

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to transfer said funds to the General Fund so that said Flood Disaster Relief Fund can be closed due to the termination of activity for which said Flood Disaster Relief Fund was created.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
