AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, a majority of members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That stop signs be erected to control the North/South bound traffic in the first N/S alley, east of South Main Street, at the intersection of the second E/W alley, North of East Main Cross Street, between 215 and 219 South Main Street rear.

SECTION 2: That stop signs be erected to control the East/West bound traffic in the first E/W alley, North of East Main Cross Street, at the intersection of the first N/S alley, East of South Main Street, between 201 and 207 South Main Street rear.

SECTION 3: That stop signs be erected to control the East/West bound traffic in the third E/W alley, North of East Main Cross Street, at the intersection of the first N/S alley, East of South Main Street, between 225 and 229 South Main Street rear.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
