

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SEASONAL EMPLOYEE CONTRACTS , AMENDING PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 2008-17 IN CONFLICT HEREIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a seasonal employee contract with Tom Crist, a level 1 employee effective March 1, 2011, at the rate of \$9.50 per hour.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a seasonal employee contract, subject to approval of council, for an additional level four employee at the rate of \$8.25 per hour.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of Ordinance 2008-17 in conflict herewith to wit: the level 1 rate of pay for seasonal employees shall be amended to reflect the current rate of pay at \$9.50 per hour.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into such agreement immediately in order that said employees can be compensated and are available for the spring and summer months.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
