

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-24

AN ORDINANCE TENTATIVELY AWARDING A CONTRACT TO CROOK'S EXCAVATION FOR THE POWELL DRIVE STORM SEWER OUTLET PROJECT IN THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Crook's Excavation be and the same is hereby tentatively awarded a contract for the Powell Drive Storm Sewer Project.

SECTION 2: That the necessary funds for completion of the project, which shall not exceed Twenty-Four Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$24,000.00), be and the same hereby is appropriated to the sewer fund (#5201).

SECTION 3: That this award is conditioned upon a certification of funds and Crooks Excavation's compliance with all bid requirements.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enter into said contract in order to complete said project in accordance with the bid and within the current construction season.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
