AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FLOOD DEVELOPMENT PERMIT FEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That prior to development within a flood hazard area, owners must complete a Flood Development Permit Application which must be approved.

SECTION 2: That the Village of Arlington shall and hereby is establishing a fee of Fifty & 00/100 Dollars (\$50.00) to offset administrative costs associated with the processing of said Flood Development Permit Applications.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into such agreement immediately in order that said permits may be processed forthwith.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
