

## ORDINANCE NO. 2012-29

### AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, Two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the additional sum of Seventeen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$17,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the General Fund (#1000) for the purpose of paying storm damage cleanup and current expenditures.

SECTION 2: That the additional sum of Seventeen Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$17,335.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the Permissive License Tax Fund (#2101) for the purpose of paying current expenditures.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that the Village of Arlington can pay said expenditures as they become due.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
