

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-10

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY, AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO MAKE AN INTER-FUND CASH ADVANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That an inter-fund cash advance be made as follows:

FROM:	General Fund(#1000)	\$ 8,056.80
TO:	Sewer Bond Retirement Fund (#5701)	\$ 8,056.80

SECTION 2: That repayment of said inter-fund cash advance will be made as follows:


FROM:	Sewer Bond Retirement Fund (#5701)	\$ 8,056.80
TO:	General Fund(#1000)	\$ 8,056.80

SECTION 3: That this is not a transfer pursuant to §5705.14 to 5705.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to make said advance in order to cover expenditures as they become due.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
