ORDINANCE NO. 2013-34

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, Two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the additional sum of Ten Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the Fire Fund (#2901) for the purpose of paying current expenditures.

SECTION 2: That the additional sum of Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the General Fund (#1000) for the purpose of paying current expenditures.

SECTION 3: That the following sums be and the same are hereby transferred:

FROM:

General Fund (#1000)

\$8,000.00

TO:

Street Fund (#2011)

\$8,000.00

SECTION 4: That the additional sum of Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00) be and the same hereby is appropriated to the Street Fund (#2011) for the purpose of paying current expenditures.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that the Village of Arlington can pay said expenditures as they become due.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
