ORDINANCE NO. 2014-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING WASTEWATER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has reviewed the current wastewater rate structure and has determined that the current wastewater rate structure results in deficit spending within the sewer fund and is insufficient to meet projected operating expenses going forward; and,

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is therefore necessary to restructure the wastewater rates charged in the Village of Arlington.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That effective July 1, 2014, there shall be imposed upon each customer a base bimonthly minimum charge of \$15.70. In addition to the base minimum charge, each customer shall pay \$3.40 for each and every 1,000 gallons of water, or any part thereof, consumed.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enact said wastewater rate increase in order to sustain the fund and meet projected operational expenses.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
