
BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Village of Arlington, Ohio, has property that is no longer needed for municipal purposes. A description of said property is contained on "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to advertise said property for sale.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington and for the further reason that continued possession of said property is a continuing liability to the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and creates a storage problem.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.




