ORDINANCE NO. 2016-03

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE AND TAKE BIDS FOR SAID PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto:

SECTION 1: That a certain piece of real estate belonging to the Village and located between 107 and 119 East Liberty Street, Arlington, Ohio is no longer needed and that same no longer serves any legitimate municipal purpose.

SECTION 2: That the property may be sold to the highest bidder after formal advertisement pursuant to R.C. §721.03.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to take bids for said property and to sell same to the highest bidder.

SECTION 4: That the Mayor is authorized to accept or reject any and all bids.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order that said useless property may be sold and the value of same received by the village.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
