

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-20

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Arlington, Ohio, has property that is no longer needed for municipal purposes, to wit; a 1992 Chevrolet, 3/4 ton pick-up truck, having Vin # ~~1G8JC34K0NE21~~ which truck is "obsolete" and "unfit" for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: That the value of said truck is estimated at less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECTION 3: That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to sell said property.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington and for the further reason that continued possession of said property is a continuing liability to the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and creates a storage problem.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
