ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 13

AN ORDINANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, OHIO, FOR THE PROPER CARE OF ANIMALS OR FOWL AND FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF SAME WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Council for the Village of Arlington desires that residents of the Village take proper care of their animals or fowl so as not to disturb the peace and wellness of Village residents.

SECTION 2: That in doing so, no person shall keep or harbor any animal or fowl in the Village so as to create noxious, or offensive odors or unsanitary conditions which are a menace to the health, comfort or safety of the public.

SECTION 2: That a violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Mayor or his designee.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage at the earliest time permitted by law.

IT IS ALSO ORDAINED that it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that result in formal action, were in meetings, open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.
