ORDINANCE NO. 2026-07

AN ORDINANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, OHIO, FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SEWER RATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Council for the Village of Arlington desires to provide its residents with proper and reliable water and sewer utility. In doing so the establishment of rates have been established and amended from time to time as necessary to maintain a quality water utility system.

SECTION 2: That it is now necessary to amend sewer rates for the continued reliable service of the Village sewer system by continuing the variable rate based on usage plus a thirteen dollar (\$13.00) monthly rate.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the additional reason that continued proper and reliable sewer service to the residents of the Village is immediately necessary.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage at the earliest time permitted by law.

IT IS ALSO ORDAINED that it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that result in formal action, were in meetings, open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.
