

RESOLUTION NO. 03- 2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF EXTRAORDINARY SICK TIME FOR KYLE CRIST AND LIGHT DUTY ASSIGNMENTS UPON HIS RETURN FROM SICK LEAVE, IN CONTRAVENTION OF ORDINANCE 2009-10, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Street Commissioner has recently under gone unexpected surgery, and;

WHEREAS, the Street Commissioner does not have sufficient sick leave accumulated and additional unpaid leave will create a financial hardship, and;

WHEREAS, the Street Commissioner can and will be able to perform his duties to the satisfaction of council with a light duty assignment upon return from sick leave, and:

WHEREAS, it is the intention of council to retain Kyle Crist as street commissioner and failure to accommodate his current needs will result in his inability to continue in this job.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Kyle Crist, street commissioner, shall be permitted to use his accumulated sick leave from 2009 as well as his unearned sick leave from 2010.

SECTION 2: That upon his return from sick leave, Kyle Crist shall be permitted to return to his position on light duty until such time as he is cleared by his physician to return to regular duty.

SECTION 3: That during such times, Kyle Crist shall continue to receive full pay in accordance with the salary ordinance currently in effect.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to pass said Resolution in order that Kyle Crist may continue to serve the village as street commissioner and the fiscal officer may continue to pay him without interruption.
