

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2014

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE TAXING AUTHORITY AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A 2.5 MILL TAX LEVY ON THE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, OHIO, PURSUANT TO O.R.C. §5705.03 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10 mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Arlington, Hancock County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to enact a tax levy resolution and authorize the placement of a 2.5 mill replacement tax levy on the ballot in the November 4, 2014 general election for tax years 2015 through 2019, inclusive, pursuant to §5705.19(A) and §5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code, replacing an existing levy providing for fire protection equipment and fire apparatus as well as providing for volunteer firefighters to operate same for the Village of Arlington, Ohio which expires at the end of tax year 2014. Said replacement tax levy shall be at the same rate as the existing tax levy.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Hancock County Auditor be and the same hereby is requested to certify to said taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the taxing authority and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a 2.5 mill tax levy on the property within the Village of Arlington, Ohio.

SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer for the Village of Arlington, Ohio, be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Hancock County Auditor in accordance with §5705.03(B).

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to pass said Resolution in order that said levy may be placed on the ballot for the November 2014 general election;

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
