RESOLUTION NO. 2-2020

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10 mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Arlington, Hancock County, Ohio;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to enact a tax levy resolution and authorize the placement of a new 1.0 mill tax levy on the ballot in the November 3, 2020 general election for tax years 2020 through 2024, inclusive, pursuant to §5705.19(I) and §5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire protection equipment, apparatus and appliances for the Village of Arlington, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Arlington, Hancock County, Ohio, for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire protection equipment, apparatus and appliances for the Village of Arlington, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5705.19(I) at a rate of 1.0 mill on each one dollar of valuation which amounts to .10 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five (5) years covering tax years 2020 through 2024, inclusive, pursuant to §5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to electors of said Village of Arlington, Hancock County, Ohio, at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Arlington, Hancock County, on the 3rd day of November, 2020, all in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.191.

SECTION 3: That said levy be placed upon the tax duplicate commencing tax year 2020 to be first collected in calendar year 2021, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 4: That the Fiscal Officer for the Village of Arlington, Ohio, be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Hancock County, Ohio, on or before 4:00 PM on August 5th, 2020, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to pass said Resolution in order that said levy may be placed on the ballot for the November 2020 general election;

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
